Abstract: The Aylesworth Ellsworth Collection is a compilation of genealogical research including journals, land deeds, marriage and birth records, family group sheets, newspaper clippings, copies of original source materials, and handwritten notes. A transcribed copy of the journal of Hattie R Ellsworth from 1875, a surname index, as well as a historical sketch of the Ascension School in Cove, Oregon are also included within the collection. Prominent surnames within the collection include Aylesworth, Ellsworth, Lyon, McDonald, Pierce and Birnie. According to the research contained in the collection, the Ellsworth—formally spelt Aylesworth—family originally hailed from Scotland and England, and resided in Rhode Island and central New York State during the early 1700's before migrating west to Oregon. Digital photographs are have been taken of the collection's oversized materials.

Administrative Information

Provenance: The Aylesworth Ellsworth Collection was donated to the Genealogical Forum of Oregon as a single compilation in book format. For the purposes of digitization, the material has been scanned as 1 file folder, consisting of 78 pages and 5 oversized images. The author's original arrangement of the papers has been preserved. The collection's five oversized items have been photographed and are available in digital format upon request with the collection.

Retention and Access: Scanned images of the collection are currently retained by the GFO Manuscript Committee in three separate digital storage locations and can be accessed via the [Manuscript Requests](#) link at the GFO Digital Manuscript website.

Processing History: Processing and description of the Aylesworth Ellsworth Collection began the spring of 2013 and scanning was completed in mid 2013. Retention of the physical items of the collection has been followed in accordance with the GFO Manuscript Committee guidelines. The collection has been kept in its original order as created by its author and their file keeping methods.

Scope and Content Note

The Aylesworth Ellsworth Collection is comprised of both copied and original source materials, i.e. correspondence, Family Group Sheets, Pedigree Charts, obituaries, noted pages from various published resources and newspaper clippings. Additional records consist of biographical and historical sketches, lineage notes and copies of land grants to various family members within both New York State and La Grande, Oregon during the mid-1800's. The collection has been scanned as a single File Folder, with the five oversized land grant items scanned separately as Images.

Characters of interest within the collection include, Stukely Ellsworth (1826-1876) and his son Mark Ellsworth, Hattie R (Ellsworth) McDonald, whose transcribed journal (dated

1875) recounts her cross-continental travels from the western to eastern United States, and Jean McDonald Birnie (1886-1974) who may have been the original author and preserver of much of the collection's items. Also included is a historical sketch of the Ascension School in Cove, Oregon, with attributions given to Mrs Hattiet McDonald, along with copies of family bible records.
