GFO Study Group Enhances Skills

Participants Practice Targeted Research and Report Writing

In early September, the GFO offered members the opportunity to participate in a study group with a focus on sharpening genealogy research skills. The book Research Like a Pro: A Genealogist's Guide by Diana Elder, AG® and Nicole Dyer was chosen for the group's inaugural curriculum. GFO's Webmaster, Ed Vandehey, facilitated this new group.

Participants were expected to

- set a research objective
- summarize what was already known about their research subject
- create timelines, locality guides, and source citations
- perform in-depth research while maintaining a research log
- analyze their findings
- formulate a conclusion with possible further study
- write a research report

Participants were also asked to conduct peer reviews on submitted assignments. A wrap-up Zoom meeting was held on February 15, 2024, for a presentation of the participants' findings and a discussion of skills learned.

The study group participants were pleased to have sharpened

their research skills. One participant said, "I answered my question in the affirmative, and the results far exceeded my expectations." Another said, "It forced me to stop chasing 'shiny objects' and focus on a single research question." While others said, "the book and study group helped me understand the value of following a more disciplined approach/process in a way that I will follow from now on" and "I learned how to research much deeper than I ever had done."

The overarching sentiment is probably best summed up in the words of one of the participants who said, "I have learned so much from this study group, the authors, [the facilitator], and all of you. Thank you for sharing your work so we could learn from each other."

Another GFO Study Group is expected to begin in the spring with a focus on the book *Research Like a Pro with DNA* also by Elder and Dyer along with Robin Wirthlin. Watch the GFO website for an announcement about the start of the new session.

Nominees Sought for Hall of Fame






2. Set up your own Bottle



Drop account online. Search the participating nonprofits to choose the Genealogical Forum of Oregon. Buy Green bags from the Customer Service desk at a Bottle Drop Center. Return them as mentioned above.

Note: Bags cost 20 cents each, plus a 40-cent processing fee when returned. The GFO pays those fees for Blue Bags. You pay the fees for Green Bags, though if you return your Green Bags to a retailer instead of a Bottle Drop Center, the retailer pays the processing fee.








GFO Offers Books for Sale on Abe Books
