#### Abstract

The bulk of the Magedanz Collection is correspondence between Betty Magedanz and family members, repositories, and other researchers. Betty's search for her mother's family began when she was 17 and found out that the woman who raised her was not her biological mother. She reached out to others to fill in the pieces of her mother's life and quickly became interested in her ancestors. The most common surnames are Hersey and Yates. The family records are found in Michigan and Massachusetts. Betty was able to trace the families back to colonial times.

## **Biographical Note**

Elizabeth "Betty" Row was born 27 November 1914 in Detroit, Wayne County, Michigan. Her mother, Grace Luella Yates, died in 1916. Her father, Jay Sylvanus Row, remarried shortly thereafter. In her papers, Betty writes about finding out about her birth mother when she was 17. She became close to her mother's sister and began exploring their common ancestors. She became very interested in the colonial history of the families and pursued membership in the Daughters of the American Revolution. She was a member of the Genealogical Forum of Oregon for several years.

Betty married Norman Arthur Magedanz on 28 May 1938 in California. They moved to Oregon and raised their two sons. Betty died on 22 May 1984.
