Abstract: The family history papers of John and Marilyn Myers are the product of many years of research into both family lines. The material was primarily bound into albums suitable for presentation to family members and other researchers. Though sources are often noted, they were not routinely included in the albums. However, the collection contains some correspondence with family members, other researchers, and repositories in the United States and Sweden. There are a few church records as well as birth, marriage, and death notices. Each album focuses on related families and includes family group records and occasional pedigree charts. Of particular interest are the many photographs of family members covering several generations.

The most common surnames are Myers, Nelson, Rosen, Anderson, and Seger. The most common locations are Sweden, Iowa, Kansas, and Oregon.

Biographical Note

John Arthur Myers, Jr., was born on 6 January 1924 in Topeka, Shawnee County, Kansas. Marilyn Joan Nelson was born on 28 December 1929 in Boone, Boone County, Iowa. They married in Humboldt County, Iowa, on 21 August 1949. After John earned his doctorate in psychology, the family moved to Salem, Marion County, Oregon, where John became head of the psychology department at Willamette University. They returned to the Midwest for a time, then settled in Central Oregon. Both John and Marilyn were active volunteers in Deschutes County for a variety of organizations including the Central Oregon Symphony Society, the Sunriver Music Festival, and the Deschutes Historical Society. John died on 16 March 2002. Marilyn died on 29 January 2012.
