Abstract: The Maranville Collection contains work compiled by Dora Belle (Maranville) Steffey. It includes correspondence, research notes, ancestor charts, and family group records. There are memoirs, letters in which family members reminisce about their early lives, and biographical sketches, all of which help tell the stories of the ancestors' lives. There are copies and transcripts of early Bible records, some of which appear to be unique to this collection.

The most common surnames are Walker, Willson, Grinnell, Foster, and Maranville. The most common locations are Massachusetts, Iowa, Kansas, Maine, Illinois, and Ohio.

Dora Belle Maranville was born on 25 December 1920 in Enid, Garfield County, Oklahoma. Her parents, Perry and Carrie (Williams) Maranville, were from Kansas and moved to Oklahoma shortly before Dora Belle's birth. She married Oran Dean Steffey (1921-2003) on 16 October 1947. They remained in Oklahoma where they raised their two children. Dora Belle died in 1989. She is buried in Ponca City, Kay County, Oklahoma.
