## Washington County Loses Last Member

FOREST GROVE, Sept. 15 (Special)—Dan (Uncle Danny) Daffron, 96, Washington county's last G. A. R. veteran, succumbed Tuesday at Jones hospital in Hillsboro from injuries received in an automobile accident on September 5 at Hillsboro.

The one-time civil war cavalryman and Indian fighter was one of Washington county's outstanding personalities. When he celebrated his 96th birthday last May, a two-day program was held, with fellow members of the Forest Grove American Legion post and Women's Relief corps and his many friends taking part.

The nonagenarian served during the civil war in company E, Kansas cavalry volunteers, in which he enlisted when he was only 17. His major assignment was Indian fighting, for his unit was kept battling the redskins in Montana and the Dakotas.

### Resident Since 1911

Born in Tennessee on March 2, 1846, he had been a resident of Forest Grove since 1911, living with his daughter, Mrs. Margaret Brennan, and son James.

The envy and despair of men half his age, Daffron often walked the mile between his home and town and made frequent trips to Portland. He recently appeared for the draft registration of men between 45 and 64 years, offering his services in another war.

He received his injuries, which included several broken ribs, in a collision between a truck and an automobile driven by another daughter, Mrs. K. Hilliard, in which he was a passenger.

Funeral arrangements will be announced from the Forest Grove undertaking parlor.
