Abstract: The files in the Young Collection support the research compiled by Brian Llewellyn Young to trace his ancestors back hundreds of years to England. They include notes and excerpts from his manuscript *Ancestral Antiquities*. These are supported by pedigree charts and family group sheets, correspondence, and a few original documents.

Administrative Information

Provenance: The Young Collection was acquired by the Genealogical Forum of Oregon in one installment 2013.

Processing History: Processing and description of the Young Collection was completed in the spring of 2021.

Biographical Note

The collection of Brian Llewellyn Young represents 48 years of effort, from 1931 to 1980. Mr. Young published extensive historical and biographical material of the British Peerage Families and the English Royal Houses with Mr. Young as the historian-genealogist and Mrs. Young as the heraldic artist. These records concern the immigrants of royal descent from whom Mr. Young is descended. In addition to this collection, the GFO has Mr. Young's book *The Ancient, Royal and Baronial Ancestry of Anna Grace Warren Munro, et. al.*

Mr. Young was born in Billings, Yellowstone County, Montana, on 13 February 1917. His parents were Martha Malina Shoop and Martin Dennis Young. Brian wrote his first historical record of his family when he was 14 years old. He died on 15 March 1997. Bettina Young was born in Toronto, Ontario, Canada, on 8 July 1919. She died on 6 June 2010.
