- 1. Stay informed: available free to everyone
 - a. Read the E-News every week, arrives Thursday evening
 - i. <u>Sign up</u>. Manage your preferences via any received periodical mailing.
 - ii. Still not receiving it?
 - 1. Check your Spam folder and junk mail.
 - Send a message to <u>gfo@gfo.org</u> and ask for help or to be "unsuppressed"
 - b. Read the *Forum Insider* (8 issues/year) delivered via email. <u>Insider archive</u> <u>Bulletin archive</u>
 - c. Check the <u>calendar</u> regularly
 - d. Sign up for <u>ORForum</u>
 - e. Follow GFO on Facebook
- 2. Get help through GFO programs: free to everyone
 - a. <u>GenTalks</u> (about 8/year) 3rd Saturday of the month, 2:30pm Pacific
