

# German Online Gazetteers and Parish Register Inventories

## German Empire

Meyers Gazetteer of the German Empire (*Meyers Orts- und Verkehrs-Lexikon des Deutschen Reiches*) was published in 1912. This gazetteer covers all localities in the German Empire, from a single house to a large city. About 60% of the entries are “see”-references. In the original volumes, churches were only listed if they are in that locality, but the online version found at <http://www.meyersgaz.org/> includes parish information.

The website <http://www.meyersgaz.org/> provides users with

- An image of the original entry with major jurisdictions listed in English.
- Detailed maps linked to many localities.
- The Evangelical and Catholic parish and/ or a list of nearby communities with churches for most entries.
- A list of related places
- The opportunity to register as having a research interest in that locality.

A detailed help guide linked on the home page explains the use of the website in detail.
