#### Abstract

The Cross Collection contains family history research compiled by Ira B. Cross. The bulk of the collection is correspondence with family members, other researchers, and repositories. The letters reveal a serious interest in finding sources and documenting the correct lineage of the different family lines. The files also include descendant reports, family group sheets, copies of vital records, copies of Bible records, and biographical sketches. There are copies of published summaries of Dr. Cross's research.

Prominent surnames include Cross, Bradford, Havley, Mobley, Hessey, Dillman, Pendleton, and Roher. Locations include Connecticut, Massachusetts, New York, and Illinois.

**Provenance**: The genealogical collection of Ira B. Cross was acquired by the Genealogical Forum of Oregon in 2016.

**Processing History:** Processing and description of the Cross Collection began in late 2016 and was completed in 2021.

## **Biographical Note**

Ira Brown Cross was born 1 December 1880 in Decatur, Macon County, Illinois. His parents were Bradford Cross and Orietta Clemmons. He married Blanche Julia Mobley in 1911 and together they raised two sons. After receiving a Ph. D. in Economics, Dr. Cross served on the faculties of Stanford University and the University of California at Berkely until his retirement in 1951.

Dr. Cross's lineage stretches back to Governor William Bradford and Priscilla Alden of the Plymouth Colony. His research and collaboration with other researchers spanned several decades. Dr. Cross died on 24 March 1977 in San Mateo County, California.
