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#### Summary

**Extent:** 50 files (1606 pages) **Language:** English

**Abstract:** The Cook collection is a compilation of personal family history research. There are also files related to research done by Mary Lucile Cook in her role as a volunteer with the Daughters of the American Revolution. Most files contain research notes and biographical sketches connected to a given surname. A few files contain obituaries clipped from Oregon newspapers from the mid-1960s. There are unique files seemingly unrelated to the collection such as cemetery readings from Louisiana. Surnames connected to Mary Lucile Cook's lineage include Cook, Whiting, Schultz, Murphy, Dunn, Jones, Crawford, and Flint.

**Provenance**: The genealogical collection of Mary Lucile Cook was acquired by the Genealogical Forum of Oregon before 2012.

**Processing History:** Processing and description of the Cook Collection was completed in 2021.

### **Biographical Note**

Mary Lucile Cook was born on 26 May 1891 in Knox County, Missouri. Her parents were Tyrone Power Cook and Maria Catherine (Kate) Shultz. Her mother died in 1898 and a few years later the family moved to Portland, Multnomah County, Oregon, where they resided in 1910. Mary remained in Portland for the rest of her life.

Mary was an early member of the Genealogical Forum of Oregon, serving as its treasurer from 1948-1949. She was also active in the local chapter of the Daughters of the American Revolution. She died in Portland on 29 October 1970 and is buried at River View Cemetery.
