Summary

Abstract: The Gehrke Collection contains genealogical and family history information gathered by the author. The collection's content primarily spans the early 18th century through the early 20th century, with correspondence dating to 1982. There are copies of newspaper clippings that cover more recent events. There are three folders that contain material that seems to be unique to this collection. The first has copies of the family Bible pages for the Covert/Byers family. The others contain handwritten lists of names and dates for births, marriages, and deaths as well as lists of people who attended family events such as reunions and anniversary celebrations. The primary surnames include Sexton/Saxton, Bird, Garner, Floch, Davis, Bryant, and Rawson.

Administrative Information

Provenance: The manuscript collection of Velma O. Gehrke was acquired by the Genealogical Forum of Oregon before 2012.

Processing History: Processing, scanning and description of the Gehrke Collection was completed in 2016 and expanded in 2025.

Biographical Note

Velma O. Gehrke was born on 8 April 1901 in Bozeman, Gallatin County, Montana. Her parents were Frank Mason Sexton and Ida May Pyle. According to her obituary, she taught in a one-room schoolhouse in Montana before moving on to Spokane, Washington, and later to Portland, Multnomah County, Oregon. Most of the material contained in the files relates to the Sexton family. In addition to these files, the GFO has three books authored by Mrs. Gehrke: [*Early Sexton Roots in America*](#) and [*Story of a Sexton Family, Volumes 1 and 2*](#). She died on 22 July 1998 and is buried at Skyline Memorial Gardens in Portland.
