# Fairfowl

Traveling to Salem, Illinois in late June for the annual reunion of Marion County soldiers and sailors were Laura Simmons, 1435 SE Umatilla street, and her sister, Ruby Baldwin, whose home is in the Montavilla district of Portland. It was a sentimental journey, planned for the purpose of paying tribute to their grandfather, Hector W. Fairfowl, who was the saluted veteran for this 82nd reunion.

Mr. Fairfowl, who was Acting First Engineer (ranking the same as a Lt. Commander) was the first U. S. Navy Civil War veteran to be so honored. A cabin boy at 14 and a sailor for 58 years, Engineer Fairfowl was aboard the

USS Benton and led the Mississippi squadron through the guns of Vicksburg during the war. He settled in Oregon in the early 1900's and died in 1912 at Lenz, Ore.

The city of Salem proudly recalls its history at the traditional ceremonies and is honored by distinguished visitors each year.

Mrs. Simmons and Mrs. Baldwin flew to Chicago, then to Vernon, Ill. where they were given a cordial welcome by Illinois relatives whom they had never met. After attending the reunion events, June 21-26, with them, they were royally entertained and were sorry to end their stay but Mrs. Simmons had made plans to go

The visit to St. Louis was marked by an excursion into the Ozarks to meet other kin and a memorable evening at the oper air opera in that city.
